



FIREWORKS REMINDER:

Despite the State of Ohio passing legislation to allow fireworks on certain dates, please remember that in most cases it is still illegal in most Painesville Township neighborhoods to discharge fireworks, even on the allowed dates.

The Following restrictions still apply:

Fireworks shall not be discharged within:
~150 feet of any spectators
~150 feet of any structure
~450 feet of railroads
~300 feet of any healthcare, residential
care or educational facility
~on any street, highway, alley or public
roadway

**Please be aware of any overhead power
and utility lines. Fireworks should never be
discharged in the direct area of overhead
lines.**

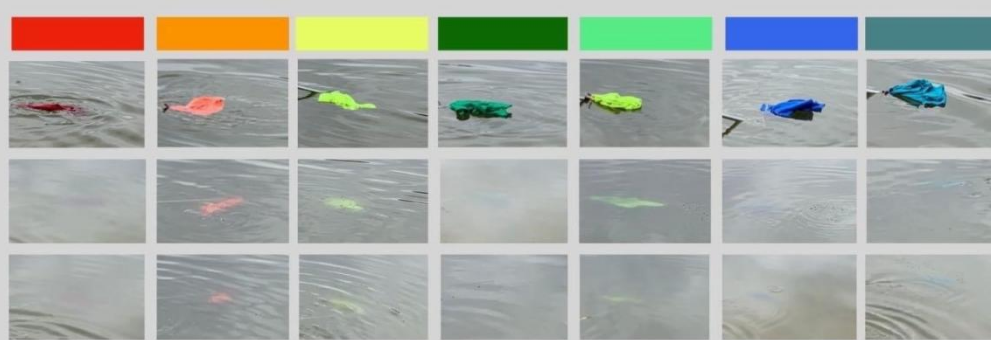
Allowed Dates and Times: July 3, 4, and 5, and the weekends immediately
before and after. Between the hours of 4 p.m.-11 p.m.



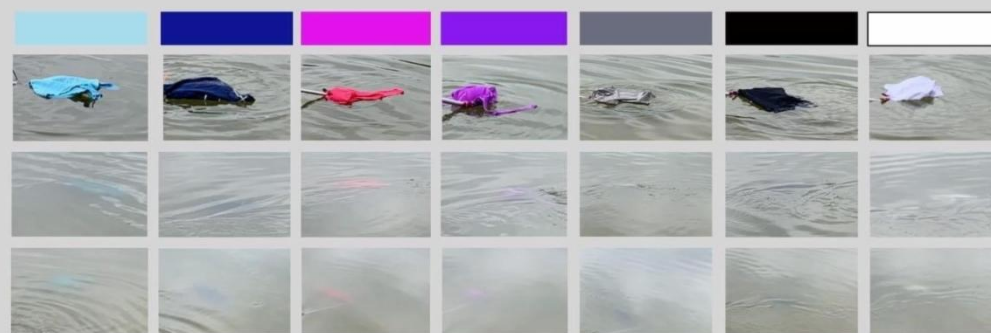
WATER SAFETY TIPS
