YOUR CLOCKS!**



A note from Chief Burchak:

As daylight saving is on the horizon and we are about to spring forward, the Painesville Township Fire Department wants to remind you that when you change your clocks next weekend you should also change the batteries in your smoke alarms.

If you have the 10-year battery life smoke alarms, please check their operation. Smoke alarm operation should be checked monthly using the test button.

Residents are reminded the Painesville Township Fire Department has partnered with the American Red Cross "Sound the Alarm – Save a Life" program. Residents can request free smoke alarms through the program simply by calling 216-361-5535 and speaking to a representative of the Red Cross. The Painesville Township Fire Department will receive your alarms and schedule a convenient time to provide the proper installation in your home.

We also urge you to purchase carbon monoxide detectors for your home. A CO detector should be installed in each bedroom and on every level of your home, including the basement.

Remember, "CHANGE YOUR CLOCKS, CHANGE YOUR BATTERIES".

from 7:30 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.

SATURDAYS - April 5th through December 6th, 2025

New Time from 9:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. **New Time**

Closed May 24th, July 5th, August 30th, and November 29th

****Open weekdays the month of November from 7:30 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. ****

ACCEPTABLE: Residential yard clean-up of limbs, twigs, branches
(no larger than 8" in diameter), grass clippings and leaves.

NOT ACCEPTABLE: Tree stumps, Contaminated materials, Steel, Wire, Plastic,
Processed lumber, Timbers, Railroad ties, Pallets etc.,
or Yard service contractors.

RESIDENTIAL CURBSIDE BRUSH PICKUP

Monday, June 9th, 2025

All brush must be tied in bundles not exceeding four feet in length
and must be placed at the curb by 7:30 a.m.

This collection is on a one time-one pass only basis.

RESIDENTIAL CURBSIDE LEAF PICKUP

Saturday, November 15th, 2025

Saturday, December 6th, 2025

Please have your bagged leaves at the curb by 7:30 a.m.

We will collect leaves in recyclable bags only - loose piles and leaves in plastic bags
will not be picked up. This collection is on a one time-one pass only basis.



CHRISTMAS TREE PICKUP

January 5th through January 30th, 2026 (weather permitting)

Please have your Christmas tree at the curb by 7:30 a.m. on January 5th

Please have your Christmas trees at the curb by 7:30 a.m. on January 2nd.
