October is recognized nationwide as **Fire Prevention and Safety Month**, a time dedicated to raising awareness and keeping our community safe. The Painesville Township Fire Department encourages all residents to take a few simple steps to reduce the risk of fire in your home:

Top Fire Safety Tips:

- **Check your smoke alarms – make sure they are working and have fresh batteries.**
- **Create and practice a home fire escape plan with your family.**
- **Keep space heaters at least 3 feet away from anything that can burn.**
- **Never leave cooking unattended – the kitchen is the leading cause of home fires.**
- **Test carbon monoxide alarms and know the signs of CO poisoning.**

This year's national theme is:

“Fire Won’t Wait. Plan Your Escape.”

The Painesville Township Fire Department will be sharing resources, safety tips, and events throughout the month to help keep our community safe. Together, we can prevent fires before they start and ensure everyone knows how to respond if one occurs.

Stay safe, practice fire prevention every day, and remember: **working smoke alarms save lives!**
