Please tarp your loads to prevent littering!

Wednesdays: April 1 through November 21 ~ 7:30 am - 3:30 pm

Saturdays: April 4 through November 21 ~ 9:00 am - 1 pm

**Open weekdays during the month of November from 7:30 am - 3:00 pm.

PLEASE NOTE: The drop off will be CLOSED on May 23, July 4 and September 5

Acceptable items: RESIDENTIAL yard clean-up, including limbs, twigs, branches (up to 8" in diameter), grass clippings and leaves.

We Do Not Accept: Tree stumps, contaminated materials, steel, wire, plastic, processed lumber timbers, railroad ties, pallets, etc, or any yard service contractors.

Residential Curbside Brush Pickup: Monday, June 8th. All brush must be tied in bundles not exceeding four feet in length and must be placed at the curb no later than 7:30 am. This is a one-pass collection.

Residential Curbside Leaf Pickup: Week of November 16th and week of November 30th. Be sure to have your BAGGED leaves at the curb no later than 7:30 am. Bags must be paper and recyclable. This is a one-pass collection.

Christmas tree pickup: January 4-January 29th, 2027. Trees placed at the curb will be picked up throughout the month. Please be sure to remove all decorations and stands.
