



Single Trash Hauler Contract Updates:



Effective July 1, 2026, all residential addresses will be serviced by Major Waste Disposal.

Later this month, all residents should receive information from Major Waste Disposal Services and the new contract details as the sole provider for trash removal service in the Township.

For the 2026-2027 initial contract year, services provided through this contract include:

Weekly garbage pickup:

(includes a 96 gallon tote): \$51 / quarter

Optional: Bi-weekly Recycling: \$12 / quarter

Optional: Weekly Yard Waste pickup: \$18 / quarter

Additionally, those with very little trash can opt to purchase 'bag tags'. Each bag tag is good for 1 pickup, up to 3 kitchen sized (13 gallon) bags: \$4.00

As a reminder, residents may opt out of services altogether, but may not contract for service with a different provider.

REVISED for the 2026 Season

Please tarp your loads to prevent littering!

The Yard Waste drop off area will be open on the following dates for 2026:

Wednesdays 7:30 am - 3:00 pm / Saturdays 9:00 am - 1:00 pm

May: 2, 6, 16, 20

August: 8, 19

June: 6, 17

September: 2, 19

July: 1, 18

October : 3, 7, 17, 21

November: 4, 14, 18

Acceptable items: RESIDENTIAL yard clean-up, including limbs, twigs, branches (up to 8" in diameter), grass clippings and leaves.

We Do Not Accept: Tree stumps, contaminated materials, steel, wire, plastic, processed lumber timbers, railroad ties, pallets, etc, or any yard service contractors.

Residential Curbside Brush Pickup: Monday, June 8th. All brush must be tied in bundles not exceeding four feet in length and must be placed at the curb no later than 7:30 am. This is a one-pass collection.

Residential Curbside Leaf Pickup: Week of November 16th and week of November 30th. Be sure to have your BAGGED leaves at the curb no later than 7:30 am. Bags must be paper and recyclable. This is a one-pass collection.

Christmas tree pickup: January 4-January 29th, 2027. Trees placed at the curb will be picked up throughout the month. Please be sure to remove all decorations and stands.

ACCEPTED: Most automotive and household cleaners; lawn, pool and unknown chemicals; lightbulbs and batteries; aerosols, empty propane tanks, kerosene, mercury, paints (oil-based), polyurethanes, primers and grout; roofing tars, shellacs, stains, thinners, turpentine and varnish.

PROHIBITED: Ammunition, explosives, latex paint (dry it & toss it), medical waste, prescription medicines, and smoke alarms (mail to manufacturer).
