

Resolution 2026 –08 Resolution Amending 2025-117 and 2026-084: Parking Motor Vehicles on Township Roads

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code, Section 505.17(A), has granted upon the Township the authority to make regulations and orders as are necessary to address vehicle parking in the township. This authorization includes, among other powers, the power to regulate parking on established roadways proximate to buildings on private property as necessary to provide access to the property by public safety vehicles and equipment.

- 1) No motor vehicle shall be parked upon the hydrant side of any road.
- 2) No motor vehicle shall be parked upon any tree lawn between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.
- 3) No motor vehicle shall be parked within fifty (50) feet of any intersection controlled by a traffic signal or stop sign, or within fifty (50) feet of a marked crosswalk.
- 4) No motor vehicle shall be parked in front of any public or private driveway.
- 5) No motor vehicle shall be parked in a manner that obstructs access to or service of any mailbox.
- 6) No motor vehicle shall be parked alongside or opposite any street excavation or obstruction when such parking would obstruct the normal flow of traffic.
- 7) Every vehicle stopped or parked upon a two-way street or roadway with adjacent curbs shall be so stopped or parked facing the same direction as traffic on that side of the street, with the right-hand wheels of such vehicle parallel to and within twelve (12) inches of the right-hand curb. This requirement shall not apply to roadways without curbs.
- 8) No motor vehicle shall be parked in a manner that obstructs the normal flow of traffic or interferes with the passage of emergency vehicles.
- 9) No motor vehicle shall be parked on any Township roadway when snowfall accumulation exceeds two (2) inches within 24 hours.
- 10) No motor vehicle shall be parked upon any Township roadway between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.
- 11) No parking of any vehicle is permitted at the roundabout intersecting Fairfield Road and Stratford Road during the following times: Monday through Friday and from 7:00 am until 5:00 pm.
- 12) Any violation of this resolution shall constitute a misdemeanor and shall be subject to the penalties provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 505.17

This parking resolution does not apply to roads owned and maintained by the Lake County Engineer's Office or the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT).
